25 wpm plus. Paul operates 99.9% CW, only going on SSB for skeds, (a look at his log recently confirmed his last phone contact was in July 1986!).

Interests oscillate between DXing and contesting somewhere around the transition between weekdays and weekends! Paul runs a modest set-up due to limited space, a TS-940S, Butternut HF6-VX, Autek MK-1 and his ever faithful Bencher, (a prized 21st birthday present).
